



Valley, Mount Sinai choose cancer care director

Dr. Ephraim Casper is the new Valley Health – Mount Sinai Director of Comprehensive Cancer Care.

Following the announcement in June of the partnership between the two entities for cancer care, Casper was selected to have a full-time presence at Valley.

Casper will play a leading role in the further growth and development of Valley’s cancer services and the integration of these services with Mount Sinai Health System, according to a joint statement.

- Initiating research programs to advance education and medical science;
- Establishing clinical information system linkages that will enhance quality, continuity, and evaluation of care; and
- Collaborating in the development of a clinically integrated physician network for the delivery of high-quality, cost-efficient care.
